



Doctor/Prescriber

- 1 All doctors/prescribers must complete the prescribers signature and printed name for each drug prescribed **within** the booklet.
- 2 Use approved NAMES, BLOCK LETTERS, Metric Dosage (opioids by mg/microgram) & English instructions. **Avoid abbreviations.**
- 3 Rewrite CHANGES in drug therapy. **Do not alter existing instructions - Always use black ink.**
- 4 DISCONTINUE a drug by drawing a line through the prescribed item. Enter the date of cancellation and your initials.

Nurse

- 1 CHECK the entries in each section before administration of the drug(s).
- 2 The nurse giving the drug **MUST** complete the ADMINISTRATION RECORD and sign, after the drugs have been administered.
- 3 Ensure all drugs are signed and prescribed by a non medical prescriber/doctor.
