Carers' app halves elderly hospital admissions – The Times 10/02/23

Hospital admissions for the elderly have been halved by an app for carers that spots when people at home need medical attention. The technology, developed by Cera, a care provider, and Faculty, an AI company, is being used by care workers. Dr Ben Maruthappu, who founded Cera after working as an A&E doctor in London, said: "Patients would regularly come into A&E who didn't need to be there. Many could have been treated [at home] instead of a hospital stay if the issue had been picked up earlier." Full article available [here](#).
