## End-of-life care to be 'stripped back' if NHS can't fund hospices hit by tax hike

Hospices providing end-of-life care have warned they will be forced to strip back their vital services if the NHS is not able to support them with funding. Rachel Reeves's plans to increase national insurance (NI) on employers in the Budget will exacerbate the "urgent funding crisis" already faced by hospices.
